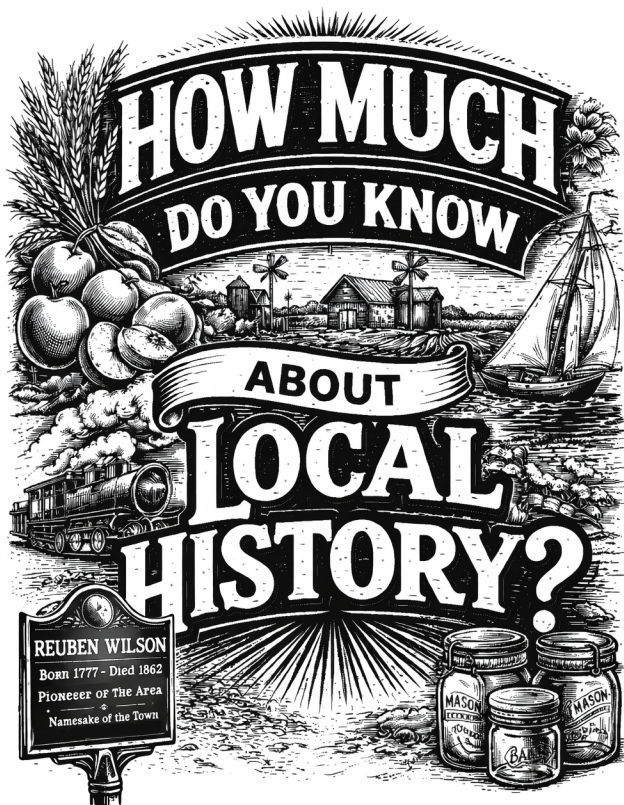

**BILLY SHERMAN:** Confederate horse brought to Wilson after the Civil War

**FLEETWING:** Schooner built in Wilson Harbor in 1863 by D. McNett

**REX TUGWELL:** Village resident who became the Governor of Puerto Rico in 1941, and was featured on the cover of Time Magazine in 1934

**LAKE ISLAND PARK:** Resort area in the early 1900s located near Clark's Island, offering a steam-powered merry-go-round and tobaggan water slide

**LAKE ONTARIO:** Wilson is located on the shores of this Great Lake

**MILLIE COOK COVE:** Spot in Wilson Harbor where the ship *Millie Cook* sank

**NIAGARA:** Region along Lake Ontario, near Niagara Falls and the Niagara River

**PORT OF ENTRY:** The growth of the Wilson Harbor in the 1800s led to it being declared an official Port of Entry into the United States

**REUBEN WILSON:** Founded the Town of Wilson in 1818

**HOJACK LINE:** Railroad that ran through Wilson in the 1800s

**SALMON:** Type of fish that lives in Lake Ontario

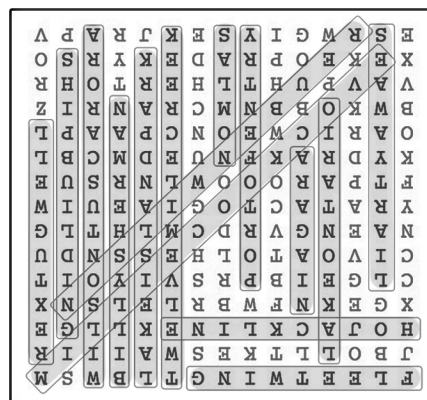
**SEAWAY TRAIL:** Driving route along Lake Ontario & Lake Erie

**SHIPBUILDING:** Many ships were built in Wilson in the mid-1800s

**TWELVE MILE CREEK:** Creek that flows into Lake Ontario

at the Wilson Tuscarora State Park

**WILSON TUSCARORA:** New York State Park, located in Wilson



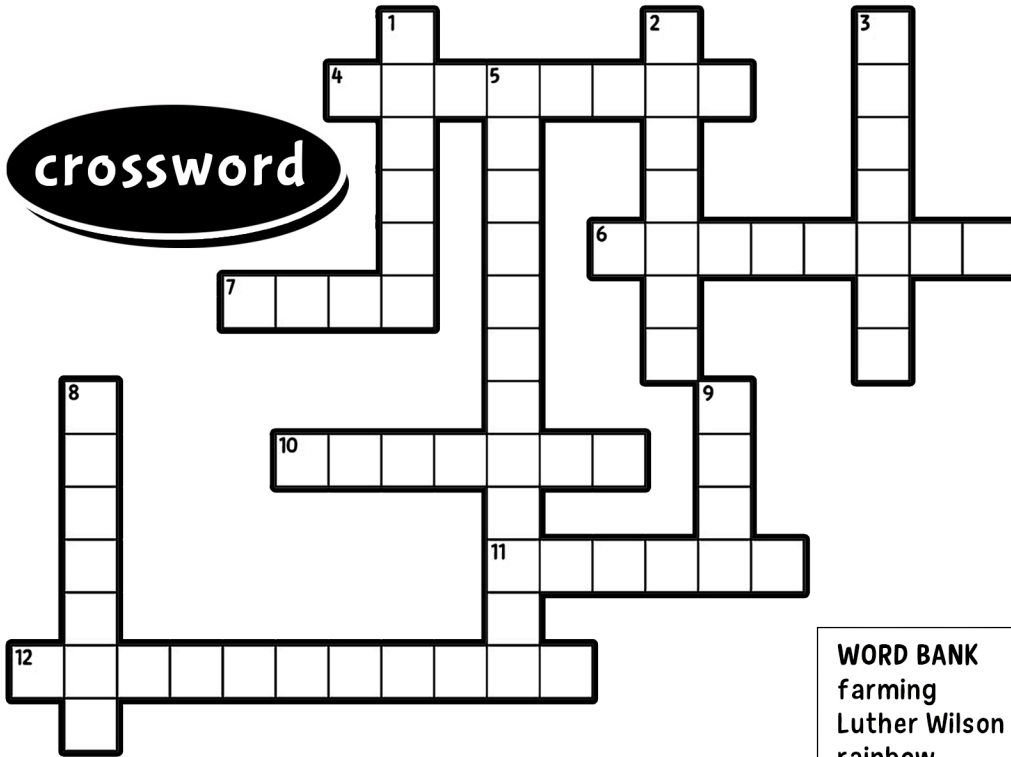

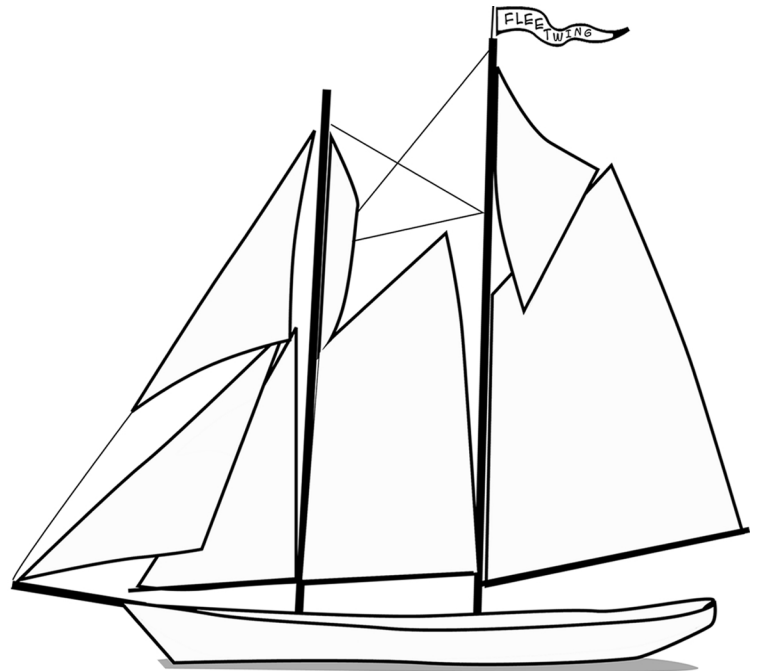
